Dear Parents/Carers,

Tuesday 21st May (Chessington World of Adventure)

As you are aware SATs will be completed at the end of this week and year 6 will be continuing this term's curriculum focus, 'Are You Brave Enough?' This trip will be used to help the children put their knowledge of Forces (Science) into context and to enrich their writing, with a real-life experience. So to Chessington we go, ready to challenge ourselves with the loops and thrills of the rides and experiences that Chessington has to offer.

Children must be at school by 8.15am at the latest as coaches will be leaving at 8.30am. Children are not required to wear school uniform, although they will need comfortable, secure shoes as they will be walking throughout the day and going on rides. Children will be bought lunch at Chessington Pizza and Pasta Buffet. They are allowed to bring up to £10.00 spending money, and can bring a camera (this cannot be their mobile phone). However, it will be their responsibility to look after it, not the schools. **We are hoping to arrive back at school by 6.30pm**, though this is, of course, traffic-dependent. We will be keeping the school informed of our progress on the journey back and you will be contacted if there are any significant delays.

For this trip, we would advise that your child should bring sun cream, which they will need to apply themselves. It is also advisable for children to bring some form of wet weather clothing just in case the weather isn't perfect for the whole day.

Children will be talked through arrangements for the trip the day before and, within this, they will be shown the attached code of conduct and rules, which they must adhere to. Should it be decided that your child's behaviour is putting themselves and/or others at risk then we will ask you to come and collect them from Chessington.

If you would like your child to be make their own way home from school, please complete the form below. Please note that without this permission we will not allow your child to walk home unaccompanied.

Rules and guidance for Chessington World of Adventure.

May 21st 2019

- Acceptable behaviour, according to the school rules at all times, including whilst queuing for rides/waiting for others to disembark from rides.

- Room on a Broom ride/First Aid station if you get lost;

- Depending on the number of visitors, these rides may not be running – Ramases Revenge/Peking Heights;
